



Frequently-asked questions

Generalities

Q: When will e-ISICEM 2020 take place?

A: e-ISICEM 2020 will take place from 15-18 September, 2020. Sessions will be scheduled per half-day and once visible will remain so for the full 4-day symposium so that you can choose when to view. Live sessions will be announced in the program and notifications given in advance on twitter/facebook.

Q: Is the e-ISICEM 2020 replacing the 40th ISICEM that was due to be held in March and then postponed to September?

A. No. e-ISIECM 2020 is a new event. The 40th ISICEM has now been postponed to March 16-19, 2021.

Q: Will the sessions be interactive?

A: Some of the sessions will be streamed live and will be interactive with the possibility of voting and/or asking questions. More information on how to interact will be available soon on our website.

Registration

Q: How do I register for the e-ISICEM?

A: There are three possibilities for registration:

1. If you had already registered and paid for the 40th ISICEM in March 2020, you automatically have free registration to the e-ISICEM. There is no need to register separately for the e-ISICEM; we will send access codes nearer the time.
2. If you register and pay for the [40th ISICEM 2021](#) prior to September 1, 2020, you will automatically receive free access to e-ISICEM.

Q. I have already registered and paid my fees for ISICEM 2020 in March or September? What happens to my registration?

A. Your registration to ISICEM will be automatically carried over to next year, for the ISICEM meeting that will be held from March 16-19, 2021. In addition, you will receive complimentary access to the e-ISICEM 2020. We will send you your access code nearer the time.

Q: Will there be the opportunity to arrange group registrations?

A: No, there will be no group registrations just for the e-ISICEM. However, if you have already made a group registration for the 40th ISICEM, your group automatically has free registration for the e-ISICEM.

Program

Q: Where can I see the program?

A: The program is available on our website at <https://www.isicem.org/16/programme/index.asp>. Here you can search for topics of interest or specific speakers to make sure you don't miss anything!

Q: Will we have to listen live - I am in a different time zone and this might be difficult

A: Sessions will be scheduled per half-day and once visible will remain so for the full 4-day symposium so that you can choose when to view. Live sessions will be announced in the program and notifications given in advance on twitter/facebook. Once screened, live events will also remain visible for the full 4-day symposium.

Q: Will the sessions be interactive?

A: Some of the sessions will be streamed live and will be interactive with the possibility of voting and/or asking questions. More information on how to interact will be available soon on our website.

Q: Can we choose to watch some lectures in track A and some in track B?

A: Yes, you can watch as many sessions as you choose from both tracks.

Q: Will all lectures be available at some point?

A: Yes at the end of the 4-day e-ISICEM, all sessions will be available for registered participants to watch as often as they would like until our next physical meeting in March 2021.

CME and attendance certificates

Q: Will I receive a certificate of attendance?

A: Yes, certificates will be available after the e-ISICEM.

Q. Is the e-ISICEM accredited for CME?

A: Accreditation from the EACCME has been requested. Further information will be provided when we receive their decision.

Abstracts and e-posters

Q: My abstract was accepted for the 40th ISICEM in March. What happens now?

A: All abstracts accepted for March 2020 will be visible in e-poster format during e-ISICEM 2020. Authors will need to provide a one-page e-poster file and a 3-minute audio recording of their presentation. The deadline for receipt of these files is August 26th. Please note, the lead author needs to be registered for e-ISICEM or their e-poster will not be shown.

Q: I submitted an abstract for the September ISICEM. What happens now?

A: All abstracts accepted for the September ISICEM will be published in a supplement to the journal *Critical Care* in September 2020. Authors will also be asked to prepare a one-page e-Poster file and a short 3-minute audio recording, which will be accessible during e-ISICEM 2020. The deadline for receipt of these files is August 26th. Please note, the lead author needs to be registered for e-ISICEM or their e-poster will not be shown.

Q: I want to withdraw my abstract. How should I proceed?

A: All accepted abstracts will be published in a supplement to *Critical Care* on September 15, 2020. If you wish to withdraw your abstract from display at the e-ISICEM, please contact Colette Dutilleu at colette.dutilleu@isicem.org as soon as possible and before September 1, 2020, at the latest.

Q: Will there be a virtual exhibition?
